LANDMARKS

-Landmarks are determined in advance of a performance, are assigned a number, and could consist of the following:

Predetermined groups of musicians (i.e. saxophones & singers; or percussion and brass; or certain only certain musicians)

Particular modes (play only in the Dorian mode)

Endings (end in 30 seconds, abrupt ending, etc.)

Anything else (everyone speak, play pre-written material, make percussive sounds, etc.)

FADERS

Are shown by raising a hand up and down in front of a raised forearm, and are preceded with one of the following hand cues:

T=Tempo V=Volume
